**RE: REMINDER TO ALL PROCURING ENTITIES TO USE TANePS FOR
PROCUREMENTS TO BE CARRIED OUT IN THE FINANCIAL
YEAR 2022/2023**

Reference is made to the above subject matter.

2. Kindly take note that, it is a mandatory Legal requirement under Regulation 342 of the Public Procurement Regulations 2013, G.N. No.466 of 2013 (as amended), that, all Procuring Entities (PEs) should use Tanzania National e-Procurement System (TANePS) in carrying out all procurement activities. Furthermore, the Paymaster General, on 23rd December 2019, issued a Circular No. 4 of 2019 directing that all PEs shall not be precluded from using TANePS when carrying out any procurement activity.

3. However, it has been observed by the Authority that, currently there is inadequate response by PEs in submission of their Annual Procurement Plans (APPs) comparing with the total number of the registered PEs. It is further observed that, only few PEs transacts their procurement processes through TANePS. This implies that, most of the

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

procurement processes are partially processed through TANEPS and finalized outside TANEPS.

4. In this regard, all PEs, whether registered or not are hereby reminded to comply with the requirements of the Laws governing procurement processes together with the Government directives on the use of TANEPS by meeting all the required conditions thereto for all procurements which will be carried out in the Financial Year 2022/2023.

5. Therefore, you are hereby reminded that, any PE failing to adhere with this specific notice by 30th September, 2022 at 12 noon; necessary measures will be taken against any Public Officer in concern as provided for under Section 20(1) and Section 104(2)(d) and 104(3) of the Public Procurement Act, CAP 410, R. E. 2022 and any other enabling provisions of the Laws. The measures to taken shall include recommendation to the Permanent Secretary Treasury and Paymaster General to suspend disbursement of funds intended for all planned procurements.
