## GUIDELINES FOLLOWING UNSCHEDULED MAINTENANCE OF TANePS DURING 29-31 MARCH 2021

1. The Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA) would like to notify all stakeholders that following unscheduled maintenance of TANePS held during 29 - 31 March, 2021, TANePS was back in normal operation starting 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2021.
2. Procuring Entities (PEs) with tenders that were affected were guided on a case-by-case basis, on how to proceed with their affected tenders. Bidders are advised to obtain information on status of their tenders from TANePS portal, and participate again in procurement processes for tenders that were re-advertised.
3. The Authority has guided the Government Procurement Services Agency (GPSA), to open a second window so as to enable Bidders that were not able to submit their bids for tenders leading to contract for Common Use Items and Services (CUIS) for financial year 2021/22, to participate in the procurement processes accordingly. In this regard, Bidders are advised to obtain updated information from GPSA offices or their website [www.gpsa.go.tz](http://www.gpsa.go.tz).
